

**RESOLUTION IN RECOGNITION OF DOMINGO VILLARREAL
FOR 30 YEARS OF SERVICE TO HIDALGO COUNTY**

WHEREAS, for nearly 30 years, Domingo Villarreal has provided exceptional work and dedication to the citizens of Precinct 3; and

WHEREAS, born in Cuevitas, Texas to Domingo and Susana Villarreal, he graduated from La Joya High School in 1967 and went on to attend Pan American University; and

WHEREAS, in 1987, Mr. Villarreal began his career with the county working for former Precinct 3 Commissioner Beto Salinas as an administrative assistant. During his time with the county he has worked under nine county judges and three commissioners; and

WHEREAS, for the past 16 years he has worked as a Coordinator for Precinct 3 Commissioner Joe M. Flores. Mr. Villarreal assists Commissioner Flores in overseeing the precinct's \$8 million budget and equipment valued at \$11 million. He has contributed to the improvement of the county through several projects and initiatives, including the construction of the Precinct 3 multi-purpose building and the paving of the Linda Vista subdivision; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Villarreal has assisted Commissioner Flores in overseeing roadway infrastructure projects in coordination with Precinct 3, TxDOT and various cities, leveraging \$48 million of precinct funds to construct over \$600 million in roadway projects; and


