### **Ribbon Cutting for Mile 22 ½ Road in Pct. 4 will positively impact 120 households**

**Edinburg** – Hidalgo County residents will now have improved transportation access along Mile 22 ½ Road in North Edinburg. Precinct 4 Commissioner Joseph Palacios will host a Ribbon Cutting celebrating the full reconstruction of the roadway. The ceremony will be held at 9 a.m., Thursday, May 17 between Carmen Avila Road and Brushline Road.

“This road will impact 120 households and will be utilized as an alternate route in case of emergencies,” said Palacios. “Now, both Carmen Avila Road and Brushline Road can also be used as entrances and exits and school traffic will be minimized.”

Mile 22 ½ Road runs 3/10<sup>th</sup> of a mile in length, the new road will increase safety and assist with traffic congestion.
