Disaster Recovery Centers change hours of operation

AUSTIN, Texas –State of Texas/FEMA Disaster Recovery Centers will change their hours of operation starting Sunday, Aug. 18, 2019. All centers will be closed on Sunday and will operate from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday. Centers will be open from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday.
