Resolution honoring Monsignor Juan Nicolau Mesquida for six decades of service in the name of God

Whereas Monsignor Juan Nicolau Mesquida has faithfully served the spiritual needs of thousands of parishioners throughout the Rio Grande Valley; and

Whereas Monsignor Nicolau still remembers that life changing day more than seven decades ago when his parents left him at a seminary in his native Mallorca, Spain to bestow upon him the best education then offered in that country; and

Whereas after spending 13 years in that Mallorcan seminary, despite the hopes of his family to join the family business, Monsignor Nicolau instead decided to enter the priesthood; and

Whereas Monsignor once declared the priesthood his life and a calling to serve people; and declared that the three high points of his life were his baptism into the Catholic Church, his ordination as a Catholic priest and his naturalization as a U.S. citizen; and

Whereas Monsignor Nicolau has been administering to the spiritual needs of the people of the Rio Grande Valley in eight different parishes, including the Basilica of the National Shrine of Our Lady of San Juan del Valle where he is considered one of the original founders; and


Whereas Monsignor Nicolau recently celebrated his 60th anniversary serving as a dedicated member of the clergy; and


Whereas this anniversary prompted the Honorable Henry Cuellar, a member of the U.S. House of Representatives, to bestow on Monsignor Nicolau a Congressional Certificate of Recognition; and


Whereas the faithful of the Rio Grande Valley have joined in thanking this humble man of 82.


Now therefore, be it resolved that the Hidalgo County Commissioners Court hereby congratulates Monsignor Juan Nicolau Mesquida for his six decades of service in the name of God and thanks him for his commitment to the people of the Rio Grande Valley.


