HIDALGO COUNTY CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION WELCOMES NEW MEMBERS

Edinburg, Texas – On Thursday afternoon, Hidalgo County Judge Ramon Garcia delivered the oath of office to the newest members of the Hidalgo County Civil Service Commission. The two new commissioners were appointed by Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court on Monday, December 13, 2010, to fill the vacant positions on the board that establishes and administers a civil service system for county employees.

Mrs. Aurora Villarreal Zamora of McAllen, Texas, was appointed to serve on the commission by County Judge Ramon Garcia. Mrs. Zamora is the Director of Human Resources at McAllen ISD, bringing years of human resources experience to the commission. Commissioner Precinct 3 Joe M. Flores appointed Dr. Sonia M. Treviño of Mission, Texas. Dr. Treviño currently serves as a member of the Mission ISD Board of Trustees. Both members will serve a full term of two years.

"I am pleased that the Civil Service Commission is now complete, and ready to meet and conduct business as soon as possible," remarked Judge Garcia. "The new commissioners are two outstanding members of the community who are committed to ethically and responsibly serve in this capacity and make decisions with honesty and integrity."

Hidalgo County's Civil Service Commission was created in 1995 by the Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court, and is charged with the responsibility to adopt, publish and enforce rules relating to the selection of county employees and the procedural and substantive rights, advancement, benefits, and working conditions of county employees.
