DANIEL MARICHALAR SWORN IN AS PCT. 5 CONSTABLE

Elsa, Texas – At a ceremony held this morning, Hidalgo County Justice of the Peace Speedy Jackson administered the oath of office to Hidalgo County Commissioners' Court appointee, Constable Daniel Marichalar. Immediately after the swearing in ceremony, with Constable Marichalar at his side, Judge Jackson deputized three Precinct 5 deputy constables who will serve with the Constable.

The Precinct 5 Constable's office serves and encompasses the Delta area which includes the cities of Edcouch, Elsa, and La Villa, among other rural portions of northeastern Hidalgo County.



Among guests in attendance, including community residents and Precinct 5 employees, Precinct 1 Commissioner Joel Quintanilla welcomed and recognized the new Constable and deputies. They will continue to serve the Delta area, providing services to the community as well as working closely with the other constable offices throughout the County.

Marichalar brings into his new position a wealth of knowledge and experience, having served 14 years in law enforcement, including 10 years as a sheriff's deputy and chief deputy at the Precinct 5 Constable's office. Marichalar was previously appointed Constable in 2008.

"We are ready to work and provide all the constable services that have been missing to the people," said Marichalar. "My hope is to improve the image of the Precinct 5 Constable's office and show the residents and Hidalgo County what we can do; I'd like to ensure that our office is up to par and competitive with the other constable offices within the County."



The Constable and his deputies will continue to serve the community and residents of the Delta area until the fulfillment of his term on December 31, 2012.
