EDINBURG, TX – Hidalgo County is expected to experience a surge of arctic cold air as low temperatures move through Deep South Texas and the Rio Grande Valley. The National Weather Service in Brownsville has issued a freeze warning from Midnight to 8 a.m. on Wednesday with temperatures expected to dip into the upper 20's to low 30's. The peak of this event is anticipated to take place from 3 a.m. to 7 a.m., where there's a possibility of snow or sleet.

Hidalgo County will be open and maintain normal business hours on Wednesday. We are asking Hidalgo County employees to exercise extreme caution while on the road and to avoid dangerous driving conditions, if possible. We advise all employees to please plan accordingly and to allow extra time to reach their planned destinations.
