

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF LEGISLATION TO AUTHORIZE THE ASSESSMENT OF A FEE TO HELP FUND A NEW HIDALGO COUNTY COURTHOUSE

WHEREAS, the Hidalgo County Courthouse was originally constructed in 1954 to accommodate five courts serving a small rural community. Since then, the County has grown to become the eighth largest in the state of 254 counties with a population nearing 900,000 residents, and;

WHEREAS, today the County has 24 judicial courts and the existing building has serious health and safety issues and can no longer adequately support the needs of the county, and;

WHEREAS, the residents of Hidalgo County need a courthouse that serves the community and provides a safe and secure environment for judicial and county business, and;

WHEREAS, a new courthouse will not only accommodate the County's needs, but will also serve as one of three economic drivers, along with the City of Edinburg and UT-RGV, and;

WHEREAS, being fiscally responsible is a priority and a cornerstone of good county government, and;

WHEREAS, Commissioners Court is seeking ways to provide for the County's needs without increasing taxes, such as assessing a fee on business conducted at the courthouse, and;

WHEREAS, the Hidalgo County judiciary conduct business on a daily basis and have first-hand knowledge of the need for a new courthouse building. The Hidalgo County judiciary strongly supports the construction of a new courthouse and this resolution so long as taxes are not raised, and;


WHEREAS, legislation is required to allow Hidalgo County to assess a user fee.


