## 2016 Great Texas Warrant Round Up: Hidalgo County DA offers amnesty to offenders who pay their fees and fines before March 5

**EDINBURG** – Hidalgo County law enforcement officials will hold a news conference on plans for this year's Great Texas Warrant Round Up at 1:30 p.m. Friday, Feb. 19 in the Commissioners Courtroom, located in the Courthouse Annex Building.

Individuals with outstanding traffic warrants will be arrested during the round-up, which runs Saturday, March 5 through Sunday, March 13. In Hidalgo County, misdemeanor offenders will be able to avoid arrest by paying outstanding fees and fines prior to the round-up.
