ZERO TOLERANCE

The Judge Mario E. Ramirez, Jr., Juvenile Justice Center, Boot Camp Facility has a ZERO Tolerance policy on sexual abuse and sexual harassment. In addition, abuse, neglect and exploitation shall be reported and if applicable investigated by law enforcement.

Any person(s) known to have violated policy shall be investigated and if applicable prosecuted.

What is Sexual Abuse

*Forced or coerced intercourse or sexual contact when the victim does not consent or is unable to consent or refuse. This may include the use of fear or threat of physical violence, psychological intimidation, bullying, and physical force

What is Sexual Harassment

*Repeated and unwelcome comments or gestures of a sexual nature, including demeaning references to gender, sexually suggestive or derogatory comments about body or clothing, or obscene language or gestures.
*Repeated and unwelcome sexual advances, requests, for sexual favors, or verbal comments, gestures, or actions of a derogatory or offensive sexual nature.

MISSION STATEMENT

The Judge Mario E. Ramirez, Jr. Juvenile Justice Center Boot Camp Facility exists to rehabilitate at-risk male juvenile offenders. A continuous cycle of innovative programming, adapted from military structured discipline and mental health treatment modalities; ensures that we are postured to meet tomorrow's rehabilitation challenges. With the continued support of the Hidalgo County Juvenile Board, we will maintain the momentum established through collective efforts to transform capabilities, leadership and culture.

Goal

To provide a safe environment for all residents and staff assigned to the facilities. In addition, each facility shall hold accountable any person(s) found to have committed any form of abuse, sexual abuse or sexual harassment against another resident/staff. All residents/staff shall have the right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment.

Serious Incident and Grievance Reporting

Serious incident and grievance reporting can be made at any time a person gains knowledge of or suspects the serious incident occurred. In addition to the reporting of a serious incident, everyone shall be made aware that any allegation of exploitation, emotional abuse, verbal abuse, physical abuse, neglect, sexual abuse or sexual harassment occurring in any Juvenile Probation program or any facility shall be reported.
