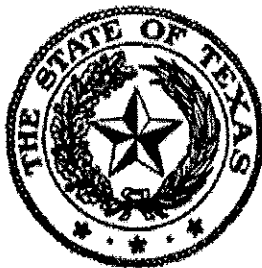


ORDER OF ASSIGNMENT ON MOTION TO RECUSE
