GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Performs entry-level nursing work; Work involves providing for the assessment, care, and treatment of patients; Works under close supervision, with minimal latitude for the use of initiative and independent judgment.

EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED

Administers medications, immunizations, and treatment as prescribed

Conducts physical, developmental, and psychosocial assessments of patient health needs and implements appropriate action

Maintains and reviews patient records

Instructs, counsels, and assists patients in meeting their health care needs

Makes hospital rounds or home visits

May provide outreach and health education

May assist in quality assurance reviews

Performs all other related duties as assigned

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

Graduation from an accredited four (4) year college or university with major course work in nursing or from an accredited nursing program

Experience in nursing work

CERTIFICATES, LICENSES AND REGISTRATION

Must be registered as a Registered Nurse by the State of Texas or a state that recognizes reciprocity through the Nurse Licensure Compact

Must have a current valid Texas motor vehicle operator's license

Must be able to be insured by the County's insurance carrier

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of nursing techniques and procedures

Ability to provide patient care and to prepare and maintain records

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to talk or hear. The employee frequently is required to stand. The employee is occasionally required to walk; sit; use hands to find, handle, or feel objects, tools or controls; reach with hands and arms; climb or balance; stoop and kneel.

The employee must occasionally lift and/or move over twenty-five (25) pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounter while performing the essential functions of this job.

The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Maintain physical conditions appropriate to the performance of assigned duties and responsibilities which may include the following:

- sitting for extended periods of time
- standing for extended periods of time
- operating assigned equipment

Maintain mental capacity which permits:

- making sound decisions and using good judgment
- demonstrating intellectual capabilities

Effectively handle a work environment and conditions which involve:

- working closely with others
- working in a multi-task environment

Maintain effective audio-visual discrimination and perception needed for:

- making observations
- reading and writing
- operating assigned equipment
- communication with others
