### **Thirty-two more people in Hidalgo County test positive for COVID-19**

**EDINBURG** – Over a two-day period, 32 more people in Hidalgo County learned that they have tested positive for the COVID-19 strain of coronavirus, Judge Richard F. Cortez said Sunday. This brings the total number of known cases of the virus to 733.

Among those infected, 38 people have been hospitalized with complications from the disease; three of those are being treated in intensive care units. "The large number of people in the hospital remind us how dangerous this virus is," Judge Cortez said. "As we have said before, this disease has not gone away and people must be careful in the public and around crowds."

The number of people being tested is also rising, which explains, in part, the rise in the number of infections. A total of 22,787 tests have now been completed in the county, including 352 who were tested during a three-day period by the State with the help of the Texas National Guard. There are currently 1,448 test results pending.
