### **Hidalgo County surpasses 1,000-mark for positive COVID-19 cases**

**EDINBURG** – Over two days this weekend 83 new COVID-19 tests came back positive pushing the total number of known cases in the county beyond the 1,000-mark, Hidalgo County Judge Richard F. Cortez said Sunday. The total case count is now at 1,050.

"This is not a moment that I like seeing," Judge Cortez said. "But it is yet another reminder of how active this virus is. Community spread is alive and well in Hidalgo County and we need to understand the dangers of that."

A total of 25,563 tests have now been administered in the county. Negative test results for Hidalgo County now total 23,563. There are now 67 people in the hospital with COVID-19 related illnesses; nine are in intensive care units. No one was released from isolation over the weekend meaning the total active cases stands at 524.

The mayors of all the affected cities have been contacted as have the four Hidalgo County Precinct Commissioners, Judge Cortez said. It has been 85 days since the first person in Hidalgo County tested positive for this infectious COVID-19 virus.
