133 more tests positive for COVID-19; one person dies from complications from the disease

EDINBURG – Over the course of the weekend, 133 new positive cases of COVID-19 were reported in Hidalgo County and another person died from complications from the disease, Hidalgo County Judge Richard F. Cortez said Sunday. The total number of positive cases is now at 1,689.

The death involved a Mission man in his 50s with underlying medical conditions.

“I want to extend my deepest condolences to this man’s family and friends. I know they were hoping to spend Father’s Day with their loved one,” Judge Cortez said. “It is all of our responsibility to take the necessary measures to minimize the spread in our community. We know what works, let’s all be part of the solution.”

There are currently 134 people hospitalized with complications from the virus; 16 of those cases are being treated in intensive care units. Forty-two people were released from isolation on Sunday meaning that they have been symptom-free for 10 days, including three days without a fever. There are currently 951 net active cases and 1,137 test results are pending.
