Seven people die with COVID-19 complications; 268 people test positive

EDINBURG – Seven residents have died due to complications related to COVID-19 and 268 people learned they tested positive for the virus, Hidalgo County Judge Richard F. Cortez said Thursday. The total number of positive cases is 4,520.

The deaths involved a Male in his 20s from Elsa; a Male in his 30s from Edinburg; a Male older than 70 from McAllen; a Male older than 70 from San Juan; a Male older than 70 from Mission; a Female older than 70 from Edinburg; and a Female older than 70 from Mission. They all had underlying medical conditions.

"As we approach the 4th of July holiday, we must not let our guard down. This is the time to stay vigilant and wear facial coverings as Governor Greg Abbott has ordered all Texans to do while out in public," said Judge Cortez. "I want to send my deepest condolences to the family and friends of these seven people. They will be greatly missed."

Due to a new reporting protocol, the hospitalizations numbers have dramatically increased. There are currently 451 people hospitalized with complications from the virus; 104 of those cases are being treated in intensive care units. There are 3,203 net active cases and 2,771 test results are pending. Eighty-three people were released from isolation on Thursday meaning that they have been symptom-free for 10 days, including three days without a fever.
