Domestic Relations Office

Children have the right to be loved and supported, economically and emotionally by both parents separated or divorced.

Hidalgo County DRO assists parents to resolve issues that arise after divorce, separation or establishment of a parent-child relationship.

When disputes arise between separated parents, trained Social Workers provide help through referrals so that children have a secure and peaceful relationship with both parents.

Services offered by DRO

The Hidalgo County Domestic Relations Office provides a range of services to address the needs of separated families going through divorce or parent-child proceedings.

- Access Facilitation
- Cooperative Parenting
- Court Ordered Orientation
- Limited Scope Investigations
- Child Custody Evaluations

Access Facilitation

The Domestic Relations Office provides services to those parties who can work on an agreement outside of the courtroom setting.

Cooperative Parenting

This four (4) hour class promotes positive co-parenting practices aimed at helping children's healthy adjustment and development during and after a family break-up.

Court Ordered Orientation

This class provides basic information to separated or divorced parents regarding shared parenting rights and duties of conservators, consequences of violating court orders and parenting time schedules.

Limited Scope Investigations

Provides specific information to the Court in less time than required for a complete child custody evaluation.

Child Custody Evaluations

Licensed Social Workers conduct evaluations and make recommendations to the Court as to the best interest of the child.
