Precinct 1 to host first dose vaccine clinic in Mercedes; online pre-registration required

MERCEDES – Hidalgo County and Hidalgo County Precinct 1 Commissioner's Office, in partnership with the City of Mercedes and Mercedes ISD, will be hosting a first-dose COVID-19 community vaccine clinic on Wednesday, April 21, 2021, at the Rio Grande Valley Livestock Show Grounds at 1000 N. Texas Ave. in Mercedes. The clinic is scheduled from 7:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Eligible residents interested in receiving a vaccine on Wednesday will be required to pre-register online at the county's website beginning today, April 19 at 5 p.m.

To pre-register online, users must create an account prior to registration.

There are 1,000 first-dose Moderna vaccines available that will be administered by appointment only. Residents are asked to arrive at least 30 minutes before their appointment.
